### Did you know??


 Dental disease doesn't just affect the mouth. There are several ways it can interfere with your pet's overall health and quality of life.

 Dental disease can lead to problems with the heart, liver, kidneys and other organs.

 Bacteria can accumulate on your pet's teeth, destroying gums, bone, and other tissues that support teeth.

 Your pet's mouth may also develop small wounds that allow bacteria to enter the bloodstream and spread throughout the body.







 A pet which appears to play with its food may in fact be suffering from dental disease; the pet may be finding the food difficult or painful to chew.

 80% of dogs and 70% of cats have dental disease by age 2.

## February Is Dental Health Month

Pets can't brush their teeth, but just like people, dogs and cats whose teeth are in poor condition may be in pain and at risk of serious health issues. Your pet relies on you for dental care to stay healthy and happy. Schedule an appointment with us if your pet shows any of these warning signs:

-  bad breath;
-  yellow-brown crust on teeth;
-  red or bleeding gums;
-  change in chewing or eating habits;
-  loose, broken, chipped, or missing teeth;
-  change in behavior; drooling.
